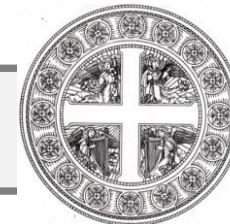


Cry out with joy to God, *all the earth*;


