

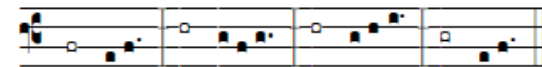

 let us hail him with a song *of praise*.





es, Lord.


I will give thanks to you, O LORD, with all my heart,

forsake not the work of your hands.


