



## Isaiah 35

### *Israel's Deliverance*

<sup>1</sup> The wilderness and the parched land will exult  
the Arabah will rejoice and bloom;

<sup>2</sup> Like the crocus it shall bloom abundantly,  
and rejoice with joyful song.

The glory of Lebanon will be given to it,  
the splendor of Carmel and Sharon;  
They will see the glory of the LORD,  
the splendor of our God.

<sup>3</sup> Strengthen hands that are feeble,  
make firm knees that are weak,

<sup>6</sup> Then the lame shall leap like a stag,  
and the mute tongue sing for joy.

For waters will burst forth in the wilderness,  
and streams in the Arabah.

<sup>7</sup> The burning sands will become pools,  
and the thirsty ground, springs of water;  
The abode where jackals crouch  
will be a marsh for the reed and papyrus.

<sup>8</sup> A highway will be there,  
called the holy way;  
No one unclean may pass over it,  
but it will be for his people;  
no traveler, not even fools, shall go astray on it.
