

my guilt I did not **hide**.

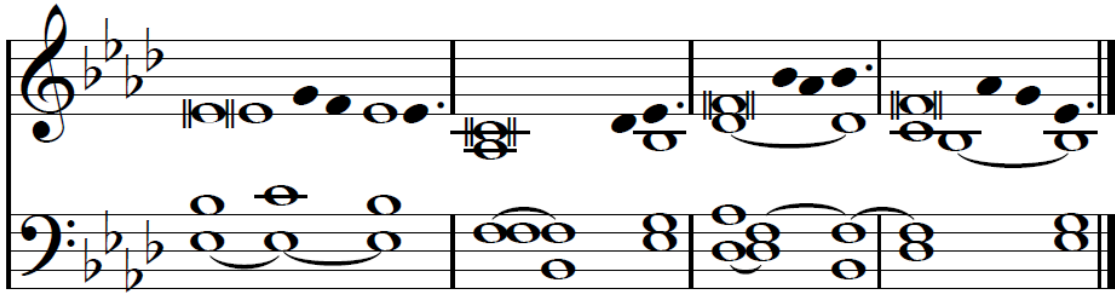
I said, "I will confess my transgression to the **LORD**."
