

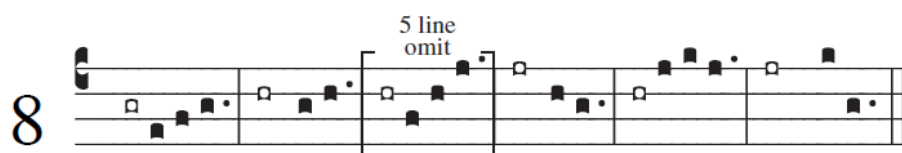
[Cf. Wis 1: 7]; Psalm 68 (67): 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7ab
