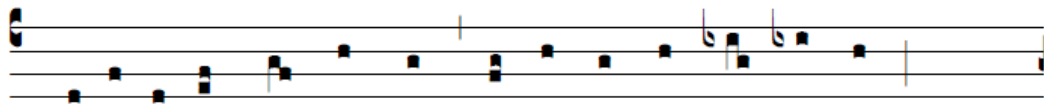
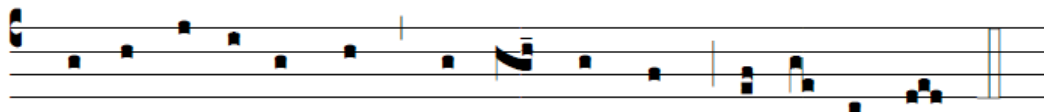




1. Be- hold, I stand at the door and knock, says the Lord.

Your cróok and your stáff will give me cómfort.

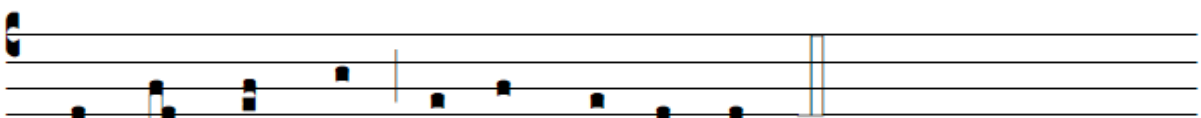
