

Gladden the soul of your servant, for I lift up my soul to you, O LORD. O LORD, you are good and for giving, full of mercy to all who call to you.


Give ear, O LORD, to my prayer, and attend to my voice in supplication. In the day of distress, I will call to you, and surely you will answer me.


