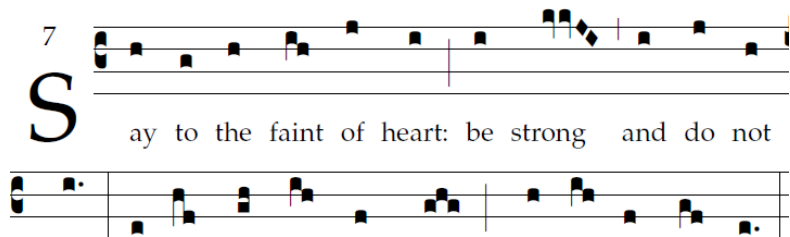


Communion Antiphon

no traveler, not even fools, shall go astray on it.

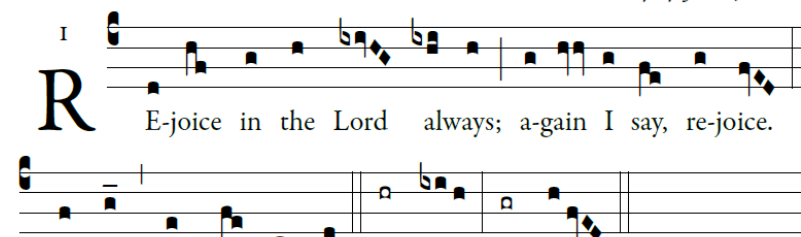
