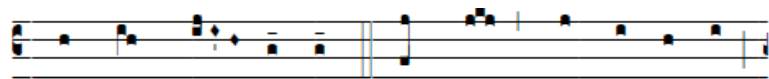

 peo-ple, al-le-lu-ia.

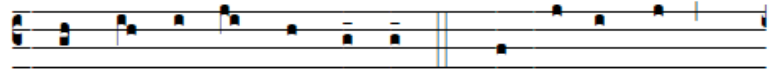
Proclaim it to the ends of *the earth*,

 your enemies *fawn upon you*.

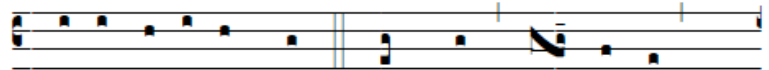

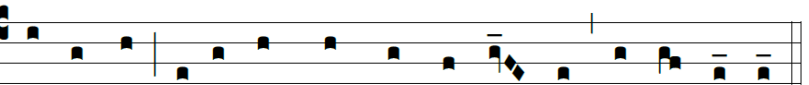
COMMUNION ANTIPHON
